



The most valuable wood of all, known as Burls (solid masses or lumps) form on the roots of certain trees and shrubs. These burls are unlike the wood that grows above, and unlike the root proper.

The world prizes these Burl growths so highly that any ordinary small burl will bring 15 to 25 times as much as the trunk portion of the very same plant.

Kaywoodies of course are made from this burl formation. THE briar in Kaywoodie pipes comes from big burls which have grown to maturity. These big burls of great age are getting scarcer all the time—and cost much more than ordinary briar which is dug up before it has a chance to grow to the proper size to make a good pipe. It requires the resources of the biggest pipe-manufacturers and consumers of briar in the world—Kaywoodie Company and Kaufmann Bros. & Bondy, Inc.—to secure a sufficient supply of these big briar burls.



ONLY THE "PRIME CUT" OF THE BRIAR IS USED IN KAYWOODIE

-Ordinary pipes are made from the Second Cuts

Many parts of every briar burl are not fit for a good pipe.

In making Kaywoodie, only the best portion is used—marked "Kaywoodie" in the above picture—where the grain is "tight" and curly and free from imperfections.

Only a very small part of the whole burl is ever used for making Kaywoodie. Some of the remainder can be used for making ordinary pipes, as shown.

The center portion marked "Waste" should never be used for pipes. It is lumber-type grain.

Only the choicest cut, used for Kaywoodie, produces sweet-smoking, long-lasting pipes—cool and satisfying.

NOTE: Flame Grain Kaywoodies too, are made from the portion marked "Kaywoodie" where the briar is closegrained and sound—but in these rare cases Nature has provided an area of unusually beautiful and clear graining and big enough so that a whole pipe can be cut from it.

How KAYWOODIE PIPES are made

The Kaywoodie pieces of briar, from the prime cut of the bowl (marked "Kaywoodie" on page 4), are boiled in a special solution, to remove the sap—and then seasoned from 6 months to 2 years, depending on their condition.

After being cut, the Kaywoodie briar bowls are rigidly inspected, to find and weed out flaws, scars or other imperfections.*

This shows one step in cutting the briar into the shape of a pipe. First you cut out the bowl, shank and tobacco chamber to rough shape, and then these "roughs" must be fashioned into about 200 distinctive shapes of Kaywoodie pipes.

Before a Kaywoodie is ready for the showcase, it goes through 128 operations. The shank is bored with precision, to assure perfect draft, and the Synchro-Stem connection, the Drinkless Attachment and the mouthpiece are fitted in with the accuracy of a watch-maker.

A man's enthusiasm for his Kaywoodie comes in no small degree from the finely-grained briar which is superior in smoking enjoyment to ordinary briar, and which becomes more beautiful as the pipe ages in service. Smokers are proud of their Kaywoodies.

Sandpapered by Hand—Kaywoodie is sand-papered 30 times —with coarse paper at first and then with finer and finer paper until the briar acquires a wonderful, hard surface, extremely durable.

From the sanded bowls, after inspection, the ones to be made into Kaywoodie pipes are selected by experts—these men have to have an almost instinctive knowledge of the wood. They have lived with briar for years and can tell from the graining whether the bowl is close-grained, absorbent and sweet-smoking. Out of every 100 briar blocks, only four finally become Kaywoodies, on the average.

The Kaywoodie pipe is polished with pumice, then with a special composition, then with Canuba wax, and then is buffed by hand. It goes without saying that no varnish or lacquer of any kind is ever used on a Kaywoodie. The beautiful permanent finish comes from individual hand-operation on high-speed friction buffs.

Mother nature is responsible for many flaws in briar. Sometimes, forming the burl, she builds her fibers about a bit of bark, a piece of earth or even a stone. Sometimes a worm builds himself a chamber in the burl. In any event, the damage can't be found until the pipe is near completion. The regular inspections, of course, disclose only flaws which are visible. K. B. & B. has recently adopted the polley of X-raying Kaywoodie pipes in order to discover foreign matter beneath the surface of the wood.

Signing IS AN ART with Kaywoodis

Ordinary pipes are nothing but a piece of briar with a hole bored in it, and a stem stuck into that piece of wood.

Master designers are at work constantly to produce new models for Kaywoodie. There's an individuality to every Kaywoodie pipe and each shape has a purpose. Here are the points that guide the designers' work.

- They must smoke cool and they must smoke sweet—design has a lot to do with this.
- 2 Kaywoodies must have the proper balance between stem and bowl so they will feel right in the mouth.
- They must have character—must add to a man's looks, not detract from them as ordinary pipes do, so—
