

Loewe introduces his Briar Pipe to London

THE OPENING in 1856 of Loewe's pipe-shop in the Haymarket marked an epoch in the history of smoking, for it was there that Loewe who, newly arrived from his native France, first introduced the pipe made of Briar to English smokers. The enterprise was a bold one for a stranger to undertake. Always conservative at heart, Englishmen were ever suspicious of change and distrustful of that which is new, and there were not wanting those who prophesied an early and ignominious failure for the Frenchman and his novel pipe.

It so happened, however, that the prophets were utterly wrong, for the pipe made of briar caught on almost immediately and business flourished exceedingly at the little Haymarket pipe-shop. In these days, of course the Loewe Briar is obtainable from all High Class Tobacconists and Stores throughout the world.



The shy sweetness of a Loewe Brian

HAT the superb Loewe Briar of to-day is the last word in smoking luxury and sweetness is recognised wherever pipe smokers foregather. Though this is due in considerable measure to the skill and craftsmanship which go to the making of a Loewe pipe, it is due in the first place to the care used in the selection of the briar root, or bruyère as it should really be called. A good pipe cannot be made from inferior wood any more than a silk purse can be evolved from the proverbial sow's ear. If your briar pipe is to possess that shy, comforting sweetness throughout its long life, if it is to retain its charm and its magical power of solace unimpaired to the end, it must be made only from the very best briar root obtainable, carefully selected, and, above all, thoroughly

matured. This last point is all too frequently overlooked. The pipe that has not been properly matured cannot be other than

UT the briar to be perfect in this respect must be matured also in its "finished" state. The fact that the root from which a pipe is made has been in the ground a hundred years does not necessarily mean that the pipe is matured and fit


for a connoisseur's appreciation. The real process of maturing has still to be undergone. This only happens after the pipe has been completed, when the sap is dried out by the natural process of seasoning which takes years to complete, and like good wine, the longer the period of maturing the better the result. Loewe briars, each built up on such long experience, receive the maturity that goes to make a perfect pipe, and not a single Loewe briar is offered for sale until the firm's experts of years' standing are satisfied that it is 'par excellence.'

A really good briar, a Loewe briar, is a joy, if not for ever, at least for a very long while. An indifferent briar is a constant source of trouble and irritation. A really bad briar is nothing short of a

catastrophe!

The smoker who has been incautious enough to purchase *just* a pipe seldom discovers the extent of his error until his first pipeful is well alight. Then, too late, he realises his mistake.

When purchasing a Loewe you have "the best pipe of all."

THE LOEWE SERVICE AFTER SALE

THE Loewe Service after sale is at the disposal of all Loewe pipe smokers. Entirely without cost Loewe experts will recondition "LOEWE" briars so that they smoke as sweetly as ever, whilst their life of usefulness will be appreciably lengthened. In order to secure the benefit of Loewe Service pipes should be posted to Loewe & Co., Ltd., Service Dept., 58, Haymarket, London, S.W.1, together with threepence in stamps to cover cost of packing and return postage for each pipe sent.

Fortunate possessors of a Loewe briar will naturally give it something more than ordinary care and attention—one does not treat a friend shabbily. Nevertheless, there may come a time when a trusted Loewe needs skilled treatment, and for this the services of Loewe experts are free of charge.

When a bowl becomes crusted it will most certainly lose a good deal of the sweetness which has been hitherto enjoyed; the finest tobacco will fail to please if the walls of the bowl be clogged and the stem choked and foul. But there is no need to despair when these things happen—such a friend can be restored to health quickly and efficiently.

A PIPE SMOKER TREATS HIS PIPE WITH GREAT RESPECT.

- Excessive corrosion or carbon inside the bowl tends to burst or crack the wall. To obviate this make use of the "LOEWE SERVICE AFTER SALE"—no charge is made.
- A broken stem or mouthpiece socket is invariably due to "knocking out" on a hard surface. If you must do this, hold your pipe near the bowl.
- ¶ In filling a new pipe do not press the tobacco into the bowl too hard, just lightly.
- ¶ Never refill a pipe without allowing it to cool; the life of the pipe is materially added to if this rule is observed.
- ¶ A pipe smokes sweeter if rested often. That is why you should have a "LOEWE" for each day of the week.


