

Each DAN pipe has a specially lined bowl, to keep it free from the taste of wood.

Each DAN pipe-shape is delivered with a special scraper for thinning the carbon crust to a fine uniform layer within the whole bowl.

All DAN pipes are subject to quality control while you are present. We check and advise you of the thickness and the shape of the mouthpiece of that pipe you have chosen to ensure that it fits exactly the position of your teeth and that the balance of the pipe is correct. We adjust the mouthpiece accordingly while you wait and under your own control, and

This service is unique in the world

Initials or a short name can be stamped in each pipe—it takes only one minute. This is an excellent idea if you want to use a DAN pipe as a *gift* or to add something very personal to the pipe you are presenting to yourself.

Should any DAN pipe burn through the side or bottom due to defective material or workmanship, a new bowl will be provided by us on request and free of charge.

Destruction of the pipe due to too tough smoking, or too heavy scraping out, will not entitle to replacement!

Photographs and silhouettes are in actual size, but each 100 per cent hand-shaped pipe will, of course, display individual deviation.

This fact characterizes quality and style, since it shows how in each block of briar the structure of the wood has been utilized to provide the highest possible

beauty as well as maximal strength.

Again just the variation inherent in the material will generally allow for minor personal wishes as to shape and make, should none of the many models shown suit you completely - most often without extra charge.

What will influence the price of the perfect pipe are: THE STRUCTURE. Well defined and symmetric lines of fibre .

COLOUR. The most expensive examples are the fair and two-coloured ones, the latter being the result of a highly specialized surface treatment created to emphasize the structural nuances of the wood.

EXTRA SELECTED pipes will satisfy all the demands laid down. However, sometimes the unique may occur, and then the price may rise to twice or

three times the minimum quotations.

FIRST QUALITY pipes with smooth scarless surface are also made from the very best blocks and appear

with an excellent finish.

SECOND QUALITY pipes are still technically perfect, but will be sold at much lowered prices because of structural short-comings, model deviations induced by small block size, scars (which may be filled), less individual finish, and somewhat dark colour.

All pipes are marked with 1, 2, or 3 asterisks (*) indicating the smoking toughness, and please state if you usually puff vigorously.

If you cannot visit our shop, we shall be very pleased to mail to you. Then use the order-sheet enclosed.

PIPE-HINTS

- 1. Buying a new pipe be sure that the boring of stem or shank canal is centred at the very bottom of the bowl. Observe that the bite of the mouthpiece is as thin as possible.
- 2. Don't moisten a new pipe before use. Don't use glycerin, spirit or other liquids.
- 3. A new pipe has to be filled up with tobacco from bottom to the very top. The heat should be evenly distributed over the whole bowl. Avoid partial filling as it produces overheating in the center.
- 4. In a properly-packed pipe, the tobacco is never too tight, but slightly loose. The tighter you pack your tobacco, the warmer your pipe will be, and of course your tongue.
- 5. The carbon crust should not be allowed to accumulate. A layer of ½ to 1 mm. is recommended. A thicker layer implies a risk for overheating and cracking the bowl.
- 6. Always use the scraper that corresponds to the internal form of your pipe bowl. Don't use a knife blade or other sharp instrument.
- 7. Never leave 'metal-systems' inside the stem. After each smoking use a simple pipe-cleaner and leave the cleaner in the pipe to absorb the moisture.
- 8. Avoid refilling a hot pipe. Rotate your pipes. If the bowl becomes too hot to handle, allow the pipe to rest and cool, since the high temperature may involve destruction of the wood!
- 9. When your pipe is hot, never remove the mouthpiece: since tenon or push is expanded – due to the heating of the material – the shank can split.
- 10. Above all the fire in your pipe will go out coming to the last third of the bowl. Do not scrape this rest of tobacco away but take away the ash and tamp the tobacco a little hardly down and fire again.

500 dollars

No matter whether to articles are brought back in the luggage or are sent later.

Orders arriving from U.S.A.

If you wish to order one pipe or several sent to your state in U.S.A. it can be sent free of duty to you.

Then fill out an order-sheet and mail it to us.

We always mail in a registered, first class letter, and to avoid the duty, we mark the letter:

"Free gift under value 10\$"

But it is only allowed to mail one letter a week to each person, therefore if many pipes there may be advantage in mailing to two or three names and addresses.

When you then have received the goods in perfect condition and have examined them, you can pay us in your personal cheque, or money order.

DO NOT PAY US BEFOREHAND!

We trust you - and you will find you can trust us. Therefore - we do not wish the payment beforehand.

Where the prices are noted from - to kroner ... please note how much you do wish to spend, up to kr..., or not over kr...
