



From the mountains that gird the Mediterranean Sea, from Italy, Greece, Algeria, Calabria, Sicily and Tuscany comes briar of rare and ancient vintage; briar that through the years has proved to be a perfect medium for making the finest in smoking pipes. The Kaywoodie Company accepts only the choicest of these rare briar burls as being suitable for its pipes, and its search for new sources is a never-ending one.



The mountainous countryside of northern Algeria is famous for briar of exceptional quality. One of the original fields discovered in Africa, it continues to provide a major portion of the high quality burls. Picture shows Algerians at work uprooting burls from the ground.



Kaywoodie has its own representatives in the various briar-producing areas. Their job is to select only the choicest briar for shipment to the Kaywoodie plant in America. Many burls are not suitable for Kaywoodies being checked or cracked or lacking the closely interwoven grain that is necessary to make fine pipes.

Only the "Prime Cut" of the Briar Burl is used...


Since the trunk of the briar bush runs through the burl to the roots, a large portion of the burl is immediately lost as a suitable material for making a pipe. But even the remaining portion of the burl has briar that Kaywoodie considers inferior for high quality pipes. By the time the briar has been selected for Kaywoodie Pipes, and the pipes finally cut, over 90% of the original burl has been discarded. Such strict grading is an absolute necessity for Kaywoodie to guarantee the smoker the very best when he buys a pipe bearing our name.

Naturally, the final judgmen a pipe is the quality of smok yields, to suit the taste of smoker. Kaywoodie Briar is only sturdy and durable, but heat-resistant, and it decrea rather than increases the tem ature of the smoke. It is select for these qualities with life-lexperience and in accorda with laboratory research.

Kaywoodie Briar is porous. It bonizes or "cakes" well. So briars which are excellent in tain respects, do not perform in other respects and are unsufor cool, sweet smoking. It woodie Briar is seasoned by own methods developed dur 100 years, and treated accord to our own processes for sweets moking enjoyment. Previous the work done by Kaywoo Company, very little effort made to improve the quality pipes.

a typical Kaywoodie Burl...

Due to the length of time required by a burl to grow to full maturity, and since they are consumed faster than they can possibly grow, specimens of great age are rare and costly. The resources of the Kaywoodie Company, the world's largest consumer of briar, are needed to secure a supply sufficient to maintain a high level of quality through the years.

These burls form above the roots of a shrub known as white heath (botanical name: Erica Arborea). The intricate, inter-woven grain makes them totally different from the roots below and limbs above it. This is true briar and it is what all Kaywoodie Pipes are made of.


From Asia Minor- Meerschaum




This is a meerschaum mine. You will notice a white stone in the picture. That is the Meerschaum. It is usually 240 to 250 feet under the surface of the ground, imbedded in red clay. Meerschaum is not clay or mineral, but is organic in origin, being the fossilized remains of minute sea animals, like coral. These little animals died many millions of years ago, and the remains of their shells were compressed by earthquakes and convulsions of the earth, washed over repeatedly by the ocean and by floods which deposited earth and rock on top of them, and were moved and shifted by floods and successive glacial movements. Today the meerschaum is found imbedded in red clay, and it is only in Asia Minor that it is found in sufficient quantity and of quality suitable for commercial use. Meerschaum is very light in weight, and is one of the most porous substances found in Nature. Kaywoodie Meerschaum is impregnated with wax which helps to give it the beautiful velvety finish for which Kaywoodie Meerschaum Pipes are famous, and helps the pipe to color.

These men work with cleavers. They are Turks and do their work at the mines in Asia Minor where most Meerschaum is found. They are cutting away the outside parts of the Meerschaum stones. During millions of years, the outside parts deteriorated due to successive moisture and dryness, and temperature changes. The process of decomposition went so far that only a kernel of sound Meerschaum is left in the middle. The decomposed outer parts are 10 to 20 times as much as the sound kernel which is used.

Synchro Stem-Metal-to-metal contact prevents binding and sticking. It is precision made. One turn removes the mouthpiece for easy cleaning. Metal strengthens the stem of pipe, protects it from breakage.

Drinkless Fitment-For hundreds of years smokers have enjoyed tobacco, but they were forced to accept along with the pleasures the "necessary evil" of the tars that were-and still are-present in all tobacco smoke. The Kaywoodie "drinkless" condensing fitment was developed to keep down the amount of tar in the smoke, to cool the smoke, and to do this without interfering with an easy "draw".

It reduces the tars in the smoke by approximately 50%; it stops moisture like a dam stops a stream; it cools the smoke; and it prevents unburned particles of

tobacco, "slugs" contaminated with tar, from reaching the smoker's mouth
