THE DUNHILL PIPE

The durability, beauty and cool sweet smoking of the Dunhill pipe with its White Spot Trade Mark, are universally acclaimed

Made from the finest quality briar (*Erica Arborea*), which is obtainable only from countries bordering on the Mediterranean, the "Dunhill" represents more than ninety separate processes spread over a period of several months. This ensures that it will smoke perfectly from the start and with proper care, will never lose its original sweetness. The mouthpiece is cut from black vulcanite which, although tough, is easy on the teeth and does not flavour the smoke. Hand-polishing enhances the beauty of the natural grain, giving the pipe-bowl a lustre that only improves with age and usage

Although scarcity of fine briar has necessitated the pricing of Dunhill Pipes according to the amount of root employed in their manufacture, it is important to remember that irrespective of size and price, they are of one quality only—the finest

Experience has shown that high quality briar root suitable for Dunhill pipes in the CLASSIC RANGE is more readily obtainable than for the shapes shown in the COLLECTORS' RANGE (see pages 15 to 25) and therefore the problems of maintaining supplies are lessened

Except where indicated all shapes are made in the four traditional Dunhill finishes:

BRUYÈRE	Carved from the roots of the Tree Heath, it is polished to a rich mahogany colour
ROOT BRIAR	A light-tan polished bowl which shows the grain to perfection
SHELL BRIAR	A near-black bowl specially treated to leave the hard grain in bold relief
TANSHELL	A light-coloured bowl with a similar finish to the Shell Briar. It darkens in use to a rich golden-brown

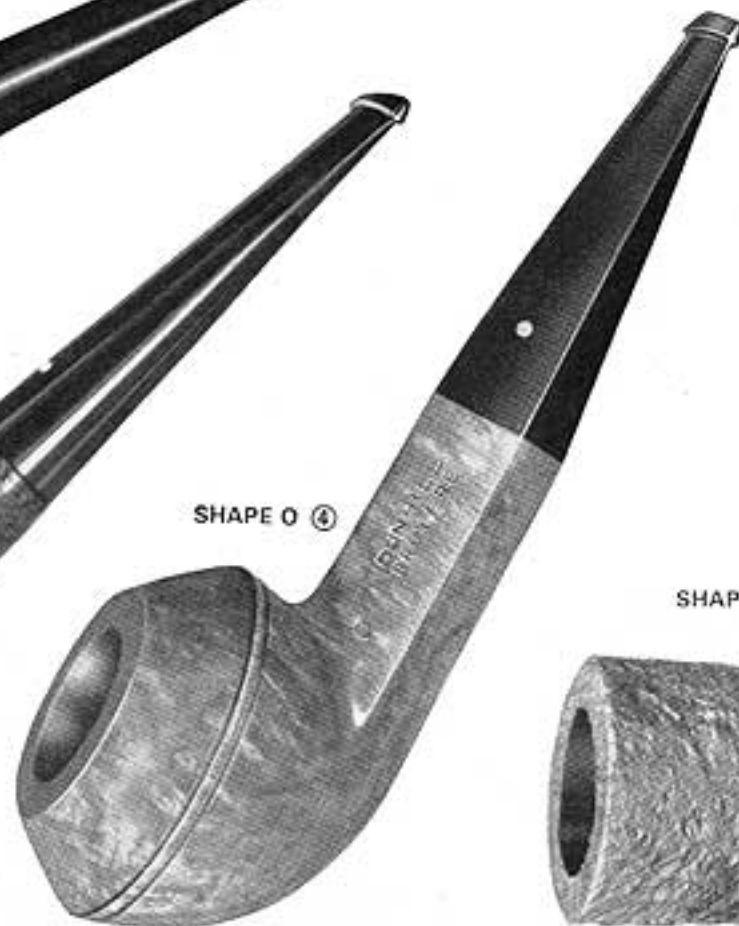
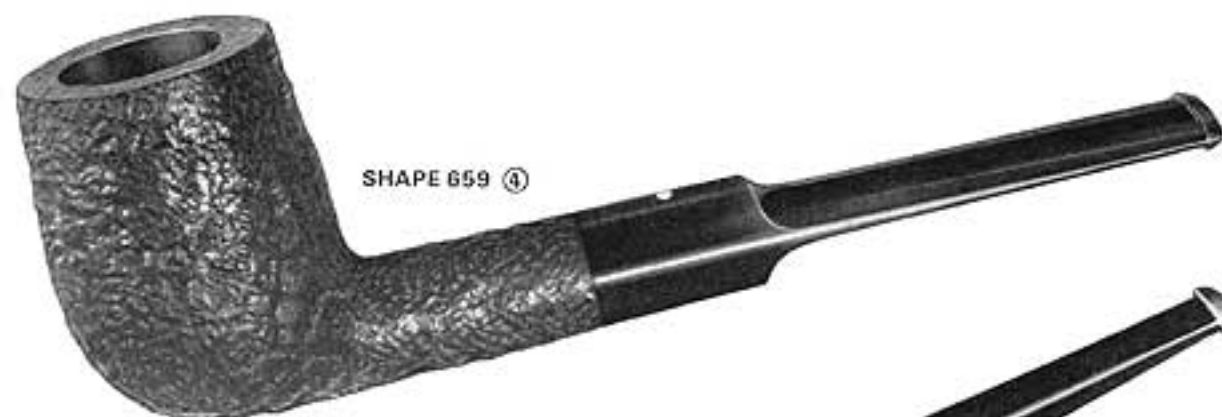

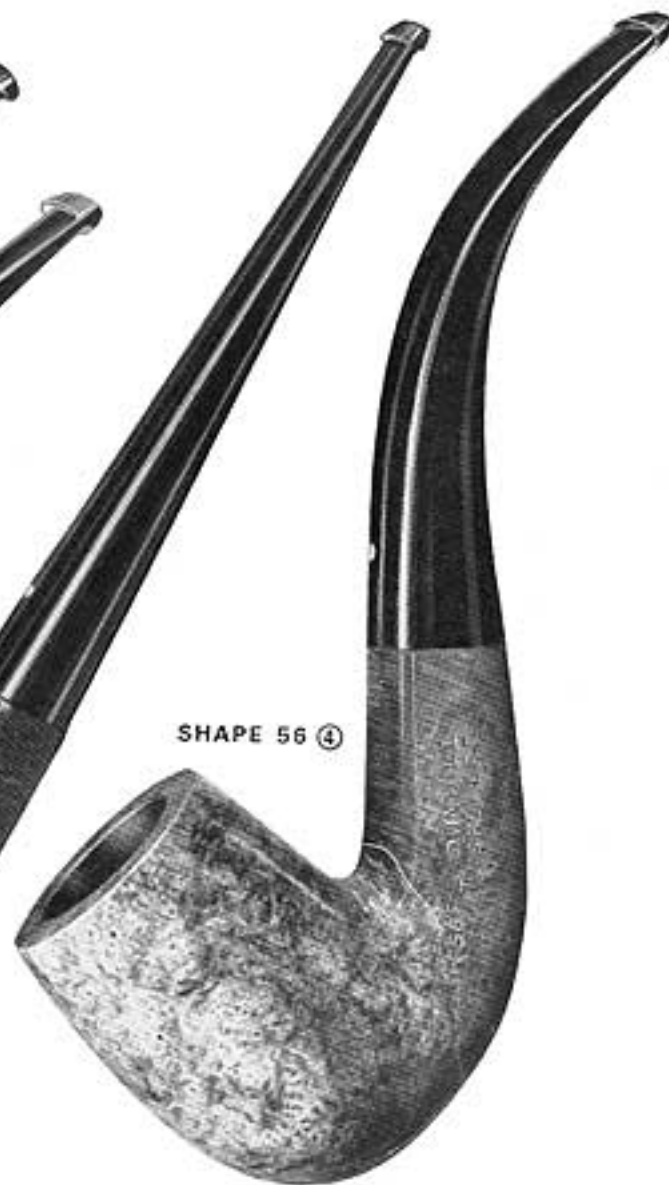

SHELL BRIAR	A near-black bowl specially treated to leave the hard grain in bold relief.
TANSHELL	A light-coloured bowl with a similar finish to the Shell Briar. It darkens in use to a rich golden-brown.
